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N3 Hit Full Strength and Dominate Round 11

Round 11 marked a milestone for N3, with all nine players finally available and able to take the court. With a full squad, Erin was able to run strong, balanced combinations across every third and carefully manage court time for players returning from injury or heavy workloads. Royals brought tight wing and circle defensive pressure early, slowing Narrikup's movement, but once N3 settled, they used smart resets, clever body positioning and composed circle rotation to break through the congestion and take control of the match.

Narrikup's consistency across all four quarters was outstanding. Royals remained competitive and physical but struggled to maintain momentum through their centre-court transition, giving N3 repeated opportunities to win ball and convert. The team set clear targets, increasing intercepts each quarter and matching their first-half scoring output, and delivered on both. Every player recorded intercepts, showing collective defensive commitment, and the group hit their goal target with confidence and discipline.

Nicole was dynamic in GA, driving strongly and creating clean options. Bonnie showed impressive confidence in a physical contest, holding her space and contesting bravely in the circle. Petra's smart circle positioning forced Royals' defenders to rethink their approach, opening up scoring lanes. Mary's fitness was remarkable after playing A2 immediately beforehand, and seeing returning players step back on court with assurance added to the lift. A composed, connected and convincing performance from N3.



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
